Conflict Review

- Process led by Conflict Review Committee (CRC) Martin Masse (Lead), with Catherine Burden and Chris Gillcash.
- Participants cleared by CRC based on information provided in Schedule B to the Conflict Declaration. Members of the CRC cleared by Fairness
- Clarification of Schedule B, if necessary, was initiated by CRC members, in consultation with Fairness
- Problematic issues identified to Evaluation Manager and presented to BESC after consultation with Fairness.
- All Participants were cleared with Fairness Commissioner between August 15th and 16th.



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Ottawa Potential Proponent Conflict Issues

The following Proponent conflict issues resolved by CRC and reported to BESC

TransitNext

- 3 identified individuals having previously worked for the City of Ottawa or having worked with Participants on other projects
 - No relevant confidential information discussed or communicated to identified individuals
- Ongoing litigation regarding Stage 1 LRT sink hole involving SNC Lavelin
 - Known litigation involving City as third party

<u>TEA</u>

- Former City of Ottawa manager currently employed by Tomlinson
 - No relevant confidential information discussed or communicated to identified individual
- WSP is part of the Bid Team and is working on the Highway 417 project
 - No relevant information relating to Trillium identified
 - Highway 417 no longer part of Confederation Line Extension Project
